By including your patent litigation in this section, the implication is that the litigation is material pending litigation of the company. We note the subsequent conclusory paragraph warns that the final resolution of the preceding litigation could have a material adverse effect on your operations. In future filings if you do not conclude that your patent litigation constitutes material legal proceedings, please include it under "Other."

Response

In future filings where we do not conclude that our patent litigation constitutes material legal proceedings, we will include it under the "Other" heading in Item 3, Legal Proceedings.
